

## 2017 President's Challenge

I hope you will take the challenge, have fun with it, and task yourself to try something new. I find it is easier to get started if there are some "jumping off" points. Here's mine for this challenge:

1. Rule #1: Have fun!!
2. The completed quilt perimeter needs to be no larger than 100 inches.
3. Color palette to be determined by your blind pull from a bag of items. Black and/or white may be added to the palette if you wish.
4. The quilt needs to incorporate in some form or fashion a log cabin block or construction. This may be as wonky, traditional, artsy or abstract as you like. See examples on the other side for different types of log cabin blocks. These are just some ideas; you may think of others. The web is a great resource.
5. Embellishment is entirely optional. The sky's the limit. Beading, stamping, stenciling, couching, painting - you name it!
6. All challenge quilts must be quilted, labeled, and edge finished - traditionally bound, faced, enveloped, or some other FINISHED edge treatment.
7. Entries are due at the December Holiday Party meeting. There will be prizes!
