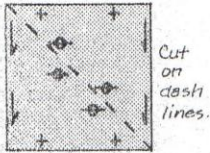

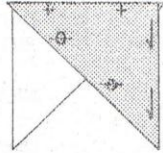
Yardage Tables - Bias Tube Construction

On fabric back, mark as shown.



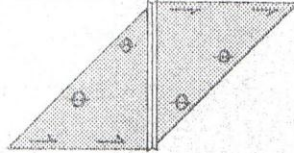
1.

Right sides together, sew on ++ edges, 1/4" seam allowance.



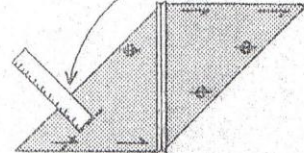

Press seam open.



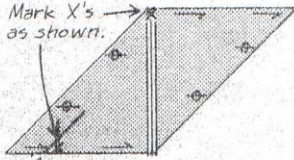

Position as shown, mark strip width wanted.



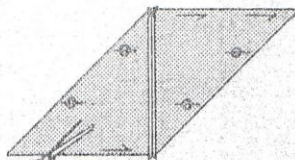
4.

Mark X's as shown.



Draw line up.

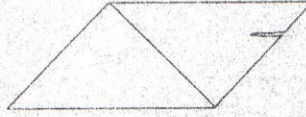

Cut up 5-6"

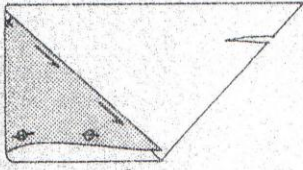

Position as shown, face up.



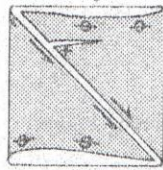

Fold in left side.



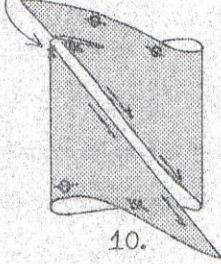

Fold in right side.



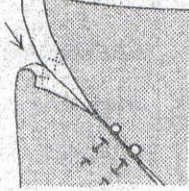

Align X's.



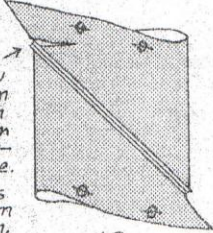

Pull up edges so X's are back-to-back - pin edges.



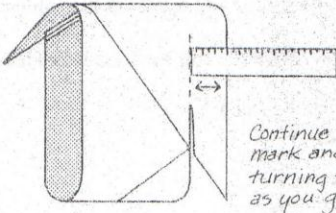

Sew seam with 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam open.

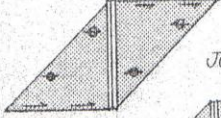
Turn right side out.

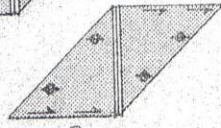
Continue to mark and cut, turning tube as you go.

Tables show no larger than 43" square. You can double any length shown by making two identical squares. Follow figures 1, 2 and 3, marking squares identically! SEE A, B.



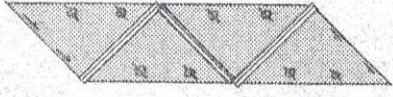

JOIN A + B.

Right sides together, sew 1/4" seam.



Press seams open.

Then continue with Figure 4, for construction.
