In a one-hour digital slide show and trunk show she will describe her personal journey from that of a traditional quilter to an artist who makes both traditional quilts and art quilts. Susan starts with a digital slideshow, which shows her work and some of the techniques she uses. Then she does a trunk show and a question-and-answer session. The focus is on ways for traditional quilters to become more creative by embracing their own “inner artist.” It is her goal to inspire and encourage quilters to try making an art quilt for several reasons: to challenge themselves, to unleash their innate creativity, to learn new techniques, to discover things about themselves through art, and to share their view of the world with others.


### Paint and Stitch: Peacock Feather

Learn the basics of painting on fabric using my peacock feather design, then stitch the details with black thread. This design was featured on the cover of Quilting Arts magazine in 2010. We will cover:

- transferring a design onto your background fabric
- basic techniques of painting on fabric
- thread sketching your piece with black thread
- quilting considerations

### Start with a Photo: Round Red Barn 6-hour \$65 (members)

This workshop is designed to help you learn the skills you need to go home, take your favorite photo, and interpret it in fabric using fusible appliqué. In the workshop, we will all be working on the same photo, a close-up shot I took of a wonderful round barn at the Shelburne Museum in Vermont. You'll learn how to:

- make a positioning overlay from clear upholstery vinyl
- cut out your fabric pieces and fuse them
- use thread to “sketch” on top of your fabric to add detail,
- color and texture.
